2 I wish we would've gotten a chance to apply what we learned more often to solidify our understanding and prepare us for real applications of the content

3 I think that some sort of discussion posts weekly where students are encouraged or required to submit the topics they found most confusing would be helpful, as there were some times where I wasn't sure I certain about a topic but I didn't feel serious enough to go to office hours.

4 Its somewhat disconnected from 'participatory' learning, which is a given being online. But the lack of direct communication, even with office hours available, has not made the course more engaging. The office hours collide with my schedule directly, and if attending those is a hassle there is little mental will to push any further and get more feedback. No amount of availability or sincere will to help will 'break' that barrier over the web, sometimes I was wishing for a mandatory, poorly handled, awkward, software/UI juggling, near-silent zoom session just for the sake of it. Like a strange ritual to perform for comfort even if very little gets done from it.

Q: What specific change in instructor communication would help your learning?

1 Overall communication is good but sometimes it takes a few days for the instructor to respond to an email. Rightfully so, it is not expected that someone should respond right away but communication appeared to get slower as the term went on.

2 Sometimes it had been hard to reach Emily via email but in general she has been accessible.

3 I believe it is slightly hard to reach the professor through email or when trying to schedule a time to meet one on one. Besides that office hours were very helpful.

1 The one thing I would change about this course would be the super long videos we have to watch weekly. It is hard to pay attention the whole time, therefore sometimes the material we are learning doesn't stick.

Q: What specific change in the relevance of the course content would help your learning?

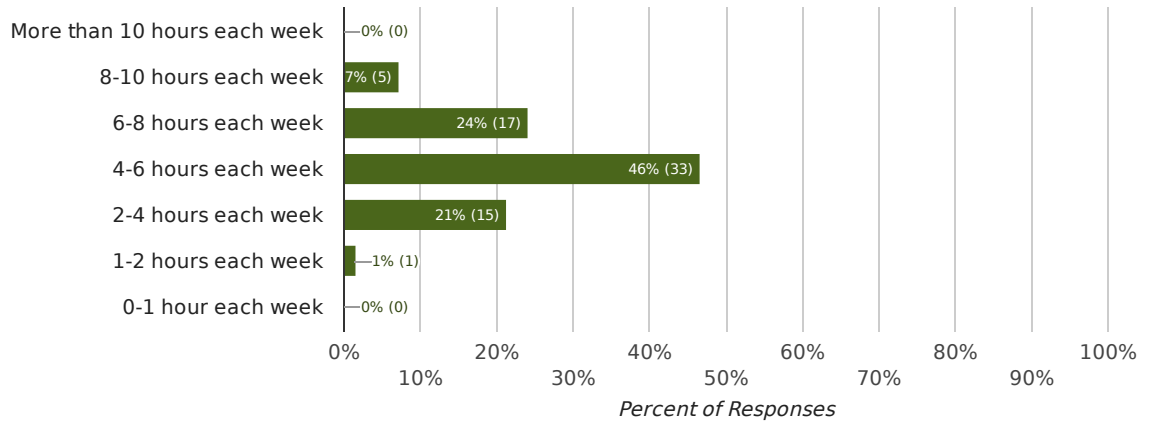
- 1 I just wish it wasn't so expensive to get course materials.

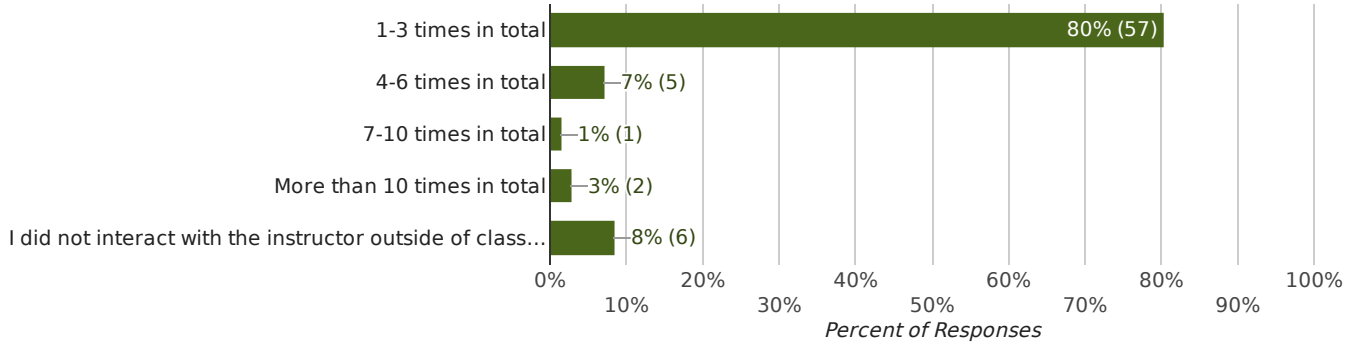
- 1 The course is very well thought out and executed

- 1 Inquizzitives are all set to the same due date, though they are relevant to the smartwork due each week. It should be clearer that they should be done in the same week to better understand topics and help students stay on track.
- 2 Smartwork being graded on correctness was something that caused a lot of stress, especially when problems are worded in a way that made it difficult to find the correct answer, forcing you to give up the point just to see how it is solved.
- 3 The only thing I can think of is a bit more guidance for the infographic project we did. Maybe an example of an old one or more details about what writing/how much written explanation should be on it.
- 4 We did a project and the rubric felt a little vague, especially in the Creativity category. It felt unclear what was expected of me.

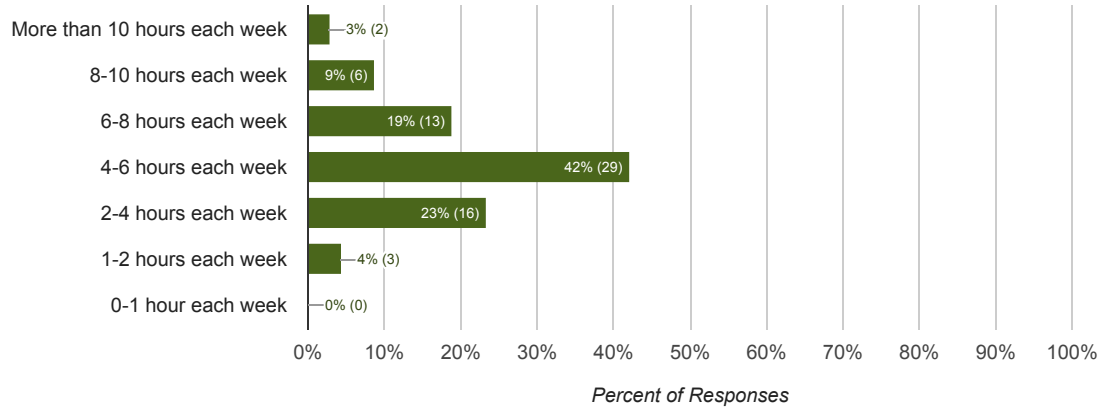

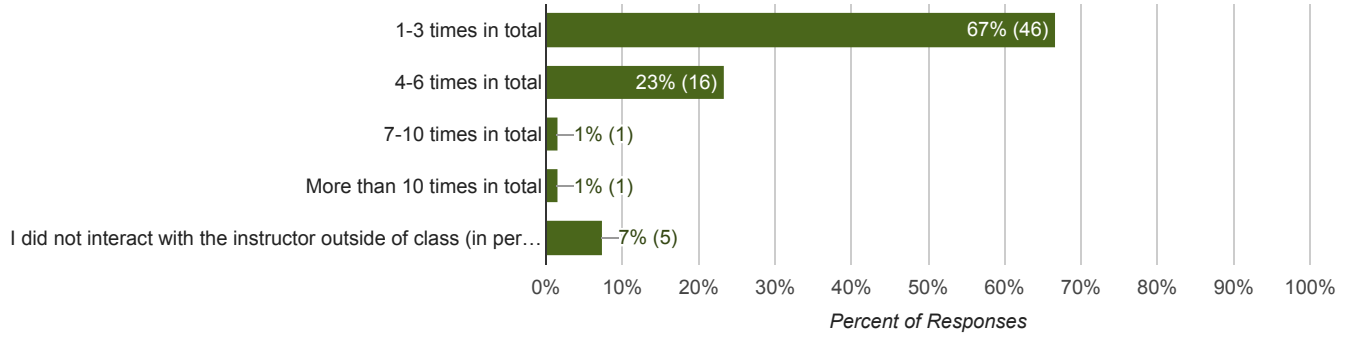
